The MSA Scholarship Fund provides for annual scholarships for education, training, and development in the general field of ***Public Administration, Public Works, Water Technology or a related course of study, e.g., engineering, maintenance, landscape design, horticulture, water management, facilities, fleet maintenance, or other related fields to be determined by the Education Committee.*** The Education Committee reviews applications and awards scholarships to persons meeting all of the criteria defined below. Applications shall be submitted on the MSA's "Scholarship Application Form" and are due on or before **June 30, 2024.** Late or incomplete applications shall not be considered. Individuals selected to receive the awards will be invited to attend the annual "Clayton Trejo Scholarship Award Program" ceremony at the General Meeting on August 13, 2024 to receive their award.

## High School or College Student Criteria

### **Applicant must:**

- Be a high school graduate or a senior in high school and have maintained a minimum 2.5 GPA during the last two years in high school.
- Be attending a community college or a four-year university and enrolled in coursework described above in italics, or, if a senior in high school, be accepted to a community college or a four-year university and planning to major in the field of study described above in italics.
- Be a legal resident.
- Submit college enrollment verification or letter of acceptance.
- Submit two letters of recommendation from the list on the previous page.
- Submit a personal statement describing your background, interests, accomplishments, and career goals. Include a list of any awards/honors received. Explain why you should be considered for the MSA Scholarship.
- Submit a sponsor letter from a current MSA member.
- Submit Unofficial copies of high school transcript (if graduating this year) or college/university transcripts if currently or previously enrolled in a college or university.

## General Services Employee Criteria

### **Applicant must:**

- Be working full-time in a related field.
- Be currently attending or accepted to a community college program (as described above in bold and italics) or a four-year university and enrolled in subjects related to the coursework described above in italics as a part-time student carrying 3 or more units.
- Be a legal resident
- Enrollment in the MSA Mentoring Program highly desirable.
- Submit enrollment verification or letter of acceptance.
- Submit two letters of recommendation; see list on previous page.
- Submit a personal statement describing your background, interests, accomplishments, and goals. Include a list of any awards/honors received. Explain why you should be considered for the MSA Scholarship.
